COVID-19 UPDATE

Yes, we're open!

On April 28th, we are continuing with routine eye care, but with a few changes to protect our patients and staff.

To reduce the number of people in the office at any given time:

- Exam appointments lengthened.
- We request that no more than 2 family members/caregivers accompany a patient to their exam when possible.
- Glasses and contact lenses pick-up will be by appointment only.

To maintain a safe and sanitary office:

- Patient and staff wellness screening
 - Prior to your visit, you will receive a wellness survey. Patients with recent symptoms/exposure will be rescheduled to a later date.
 - Upon entry, every visitor will be screened with a non-contact thermometer to ensure they do not have a fever.
 - Staff screened daily and kept at home if risk of illness.
- Extensive cleaning of the office prior to and throughout each day.
- Glasses sanitized via UV irradiation cabinet after handling and prior to pick-up.
- Doctor will wear mask for every encounter.
- Patients encouraged to wear mask, though not mandatory for entry.

To provide care for high-risk patients:

- The first appointment of the day is reserved for high-risk patients.
 - High risk patients include those with asthma, respiratory issues, immune-compromised.
 - These appointments may be scheduled by phone-only.
